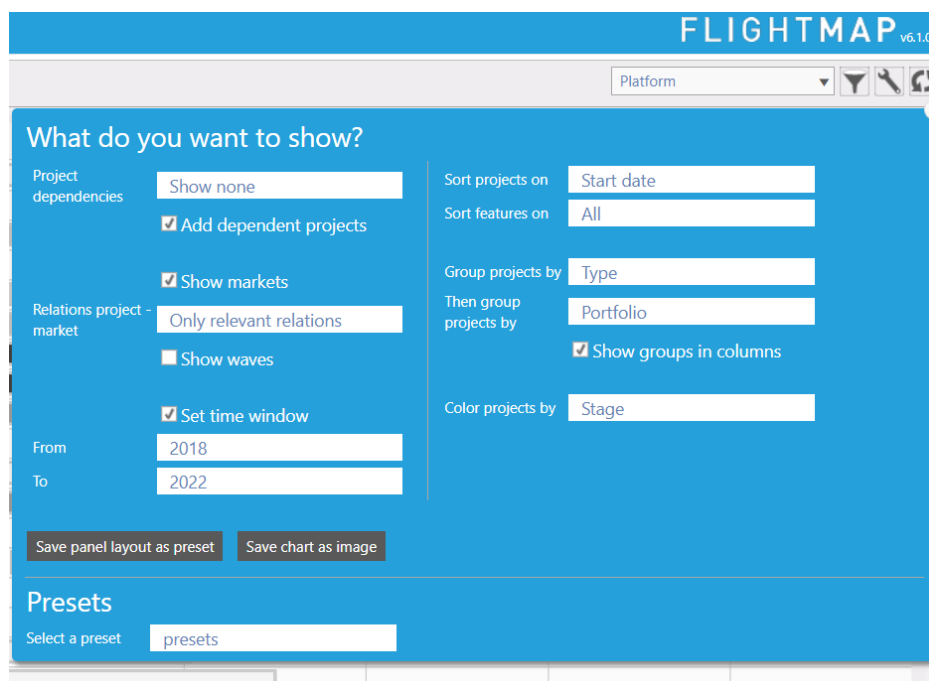


FLIGHTMAP 6.1 Release

FLIGHTMAP 6.1 is the next minor release of FLIGHTMAP. It offers improvements for sorting and filtering in the roadmap, enhanced flexibility for configuring the Single Sign On option, as well as a number of minor bug fixes and performance improvements.

Feature	Description
Roadmap sort & filtering	<p>In FLIGHTMAP 6.1, users can have a new range of options to specify the sort order of projects and features in the roadmap chart, to support new use cases for grouping and sorting of projects: sort by name and by start date, grouped according to dependencies between projects. Sorting by wave creates swim-lanes for each wave in the roadmap.</p> <p>Features can now be sorted according their new feature priority property. This helps to focus on the most important features. Feature priority can be differentiated by portfolio.</p>

Single Sign On

FLIGHTMAP already offers the option to link to an external identity provider (such as a company's own directory) via the so-called Single Sign On optional module. In FLIGHTMAP 6.1, user accounts in FLIGHTMAP can have a dedicated alias that links the FLIGHTMAP user account settings (such as roles and rights) to the specific user identification provided by the identity provider.

The Single Sign On module supports all identity provider with the SAML 2.0 standard protocol, and has been tested with major solutions such as Microsoft's Office365 and ADFS.
